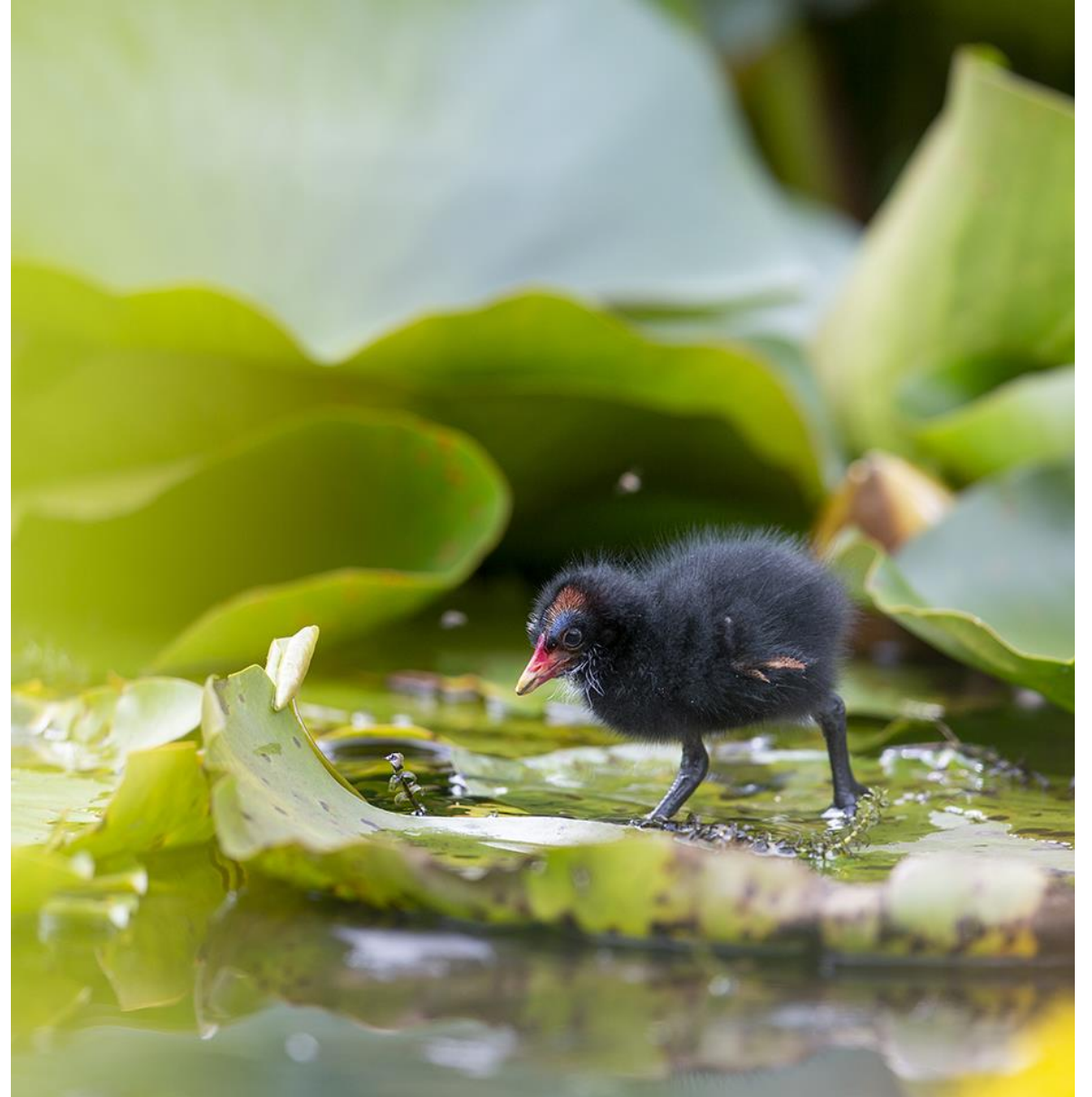

Why report?

- OECMs are likely to be widespread but they cannot be factored into decision-making until they are identified and mapped

- Future Target 3 cannot be accurately tracked until OECMs are identified and mapped globally

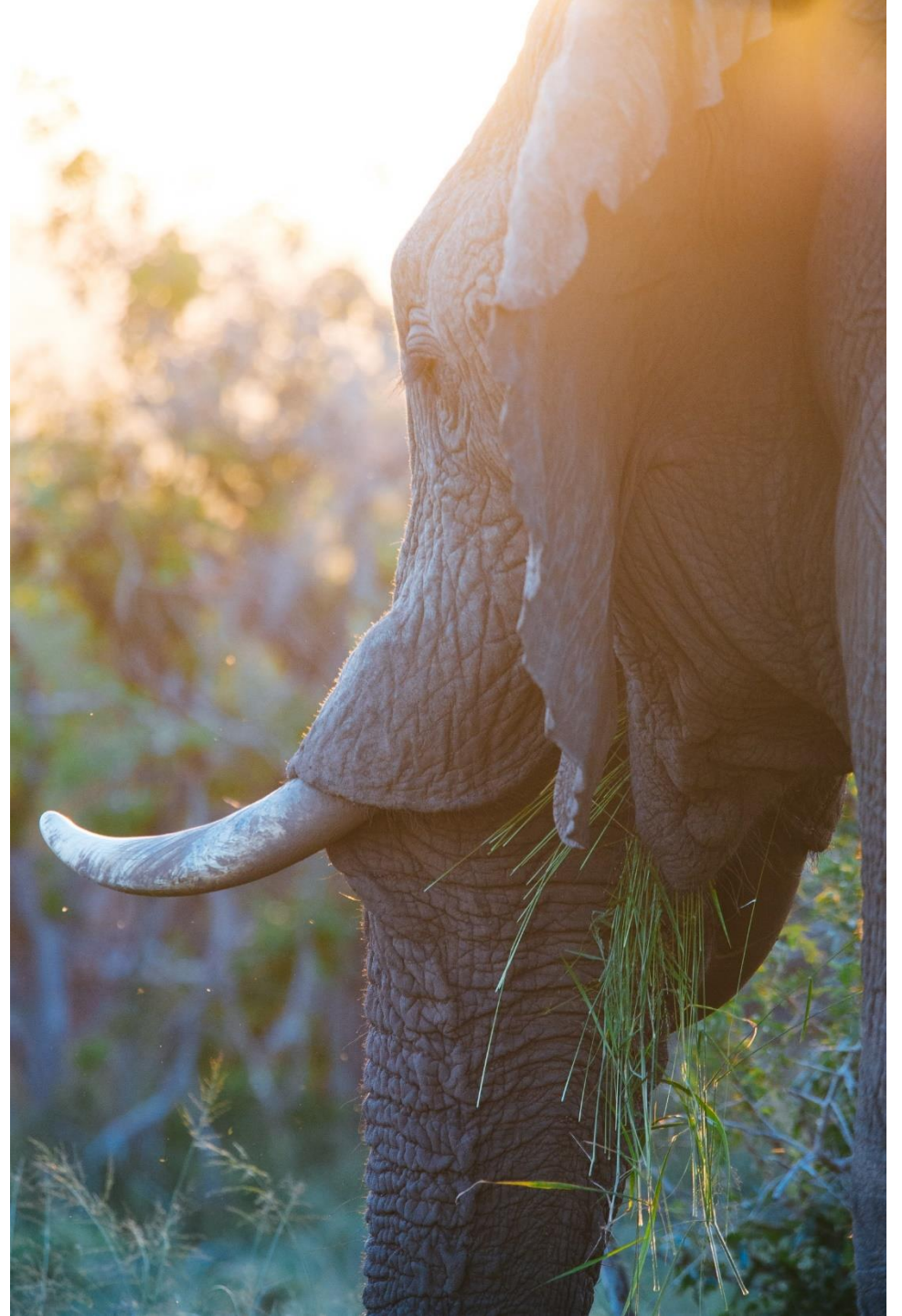
Why report?

- This makes it hard to set global and regional priorities and plan for the future of conservation (and other land/sea uses)

How to report

- Once an OEEM has been identified, it can be reported to the WD-OEEM, often by the national government.
- Reporting is often done by the national government.
- Data needs to be provided in a specific format. This is described in more detail in the User Manual:

How to report

Three key steps:

1. Obtain consent: consent should be provided by the governance authority (the people who make decisions about how the OECM is managed)
2. Format the data correctly
3. Send the data to oeem@unep-wcmc.org

What do I need to send?

1. Spatial (GIS) data: a polygon or point for each OECM
2. Tabular data, e.g. name and governance type. You can include a link to supporting information if available, e.g. the results of the IUCN methodology
3. A signed data-contributor agreement
