

Why report?

 OECMs are likely to be widespread but they cannot be factored into decision-making until they are identified and mapped


Why report?


Why report?

 This makes it hard to set global and regional priorities and plan for the future of conservation (and other land/sea uses)

The World Database on OECMs exists to address this, providing a single, standardised source of data on the world's OECMs



How to report

- Once an OECM has been identified, it can be reported to the WD-OECM, often by the national government.
- Reporting is often done by the national government.
- Data needs to be provided in a specific format. This
 is described in more detail in the User Manual:

How to report

Three key steps:

- Obtain consent: consent should be provided by the governance authority (the people who make decisions about how the OECM is managed)
- 2. Format the data correctly
- 3. Send the data to oecm@unep-wcmc.org

What do I need to send?

- Spatial (GIS) data: a polygon or point for each OECM
- 2. Tabular data, e.g. name and governance type. You can include a link to supporting information if available, e.g. the results of the IUCN methodology
- 3. A signed data-contributor agreement
