How to edit our 2nd book?

The part composition of our 1st book may be good. If we follow the previous way, we have to identify an editor(s) for each part. However, it is not so easy to do so for us, because we do not know which researcher conduct what kind of researches. So, it may be complicated for an editor(s) to identify appropriate authors who belong to different working groups (or other research fields), even if we identify her/him as an editor.

So, I think more efficient way for us to edit our 2nd book would be as below:

- 1.The leader of each working group (gene/species, forest, freshwater and marine) make call-for-papers to the researchers who belong to the leader's working group.
- 2.If the above is not efficient, the leader ask the researchers who belong to the leader's working group or whose research field related to the leader's one.
- 3.Anyhow, each working group leader collect manuscripts to be contributed to our 2nd book.
- 4.Those leaders submit manuscripts thus collected to Chief Editor (Nakano).
- 5.Yahara, Nakashizuka and Nakano distribute each manuscript to an appropriate part.
- 6.We can change title(s) or composition of part, if necessary.
