
Symbol Concept





Symbol only

Don'ts (Change of the symbol shapes, colors, etc.)

A: Don't break up (Use in the specified combination)



B: Don't change the shape (Use the specified shape)



C: Don't use the different colors (Use the specified colors)



Don'ts (The symbol background colors)

D: Don't use colors on backgrounds (Use on white backgrounds in principle)



* Only CMYK 10% in total are allowed to use for background colors.

E: Don't use the outline symbol on dark-colored backgrounds (Follow specifications)





Keep 0.25 of the width (X) around of all its sides.
